Emergency Medical and Evacuation Insurance – Are you covered?

No one ever plans to have an accident or to need medical care while on your ski trip, but if you do, you want to make sure that you have insurance to cover ALL unforeseen expenses.

If you have the misfortune of being injured or ill and need to be evacuated by helicopter from the backcountry it can cost hundreds, even thousands, of dollars.

Air Ambulance will not service the backcountry. SAR rescue is not an option. When we need to get an injured person out of the backcountry or an ill person out of our lodge, we call our helicopter provider to come asap. This results in a hefty bill that the evacuee is responsible for.

If you have a policy please read carefully to make sure you have coverage for evacuation from a remote location.

Trip Cancellation/Interruption – Are you covered?

We understand that occasionally events occur that prevent you from joining us for your vacation. Life is full of surprises and so is travel! You can't predict a missed flight connection, job loss or the death of a family member or your own early season ski injury. When an unexpected event prevents you from travelling, Trip Cancellation/Trip Interruption reimburses travel costs if your trip is cancelled before you leave or disrupted after it has begun.

Please pay special attention to our Cancellation and Refunds Terms.

To avoid any financial hardship that an unexpected cancellation or interruption could cause, we strongly recommend purchasing Trip Cancellation/Interruption to protect your trip investment. Trip Cancellation/Interruption costs about 5% of your trip cost and it's worth the peace of mind!

If you find that you are not already covered for any of the above circumstances you have options!

Visiting Canada as a Tourist

Most people need a Visa or an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) to fly to or transit through Canada. (US Citizens will only require a passport).

Be prepared: Apply for an eTA as soon as possible. Most applicants are approved within minutes. However, there is the possibility of a delay or a denial.

It is recommended you arrange your eTA as soon as possible to pre-determine your entry status.
