Valkyr Guidelines for bringing liquor to Lodges

BEER. Let's face it there's nothing better to relax well used muscles than a good pint of beer! And we can help you with that! We have **Nelson Brewery Faceplant Ale and Wild Honey Ale on tap** at Hilda Hut and Valkyr Lodge.

We sell it for \$6 / pint and you can also pre-order kegs for your group at \$350 / 50 L. If you give us a 2-week lead time we can have your favorite brew on tap!

If you prefer to bring your own brand of beer, make sure it's in cans, not bottles. Secure your cans in sealed boxes. Do not bring flats that are loosely taped, they will fall apart.

We don't sell any hard liquor so you'll want to pack in your favorite nightcap. Running short can be a cause for worry, but please don't bring more than you can reasonably drink. It's nice to share with your ski pals but coordinate with the members of your group and make sure everyone knows what everyone else is bringing to share.

Consider using a smaller bottle or plastic bottle to repack your booze into. Glass bottles are heavy and add unnecessary weight to the helicopter flights.

WINE: We have red and white wine available at the lodges. We include a glass at dinner with our catered package and we have more for purchase at \$6 / 5 0z serving.

If you are bringing wine, please consider bringing a boxed variety. *Chateau Carton* is not as bad as you might think!

FOR SELF-CATERED GROUPS: The recommended weight allowance for food and drink is 70 - 75 lbs per person per week. For more information, please see our Guidelines for Self-Catered Groups. Our rates cover the outlined weight allowances. If your cargo is over-sized or overweight and requires an extra helicopter trip there will be a surcharge for the group. This charge will cover the full cycle from staging to the lodge and return and could be \$500 - \$800.
