

## Fairy Meadow Ski Week Staging area and Flight Details

The staging area for the Fairy Meadow ski weeks has changed this year. Provided below is more information of getting to the staging area and details on the flight times.

Helicopter flights (inbound and outbound) happen on Saturdays. You will need to be at the staging area for 11am (MST). If you are coming from Revelstoke, remember you will be in a different time zone (PMT is 1 hour behind MST). Groups flying out of the Fairy Meadow cabin will need to be ready for the first flights arrival at around 12pm.

Our invoices can be confusing as they show the last night at the cabin rather than the check out day. **All ski weeks changeover on Saturdays**, and if weather cooperates then all flights are completed by 4-4:30pm

Alpine Helicopters is contracted to fly our guests and the pilots have flown the Fairy Meadow ski groups for many years. They try to get everyone and their luggage up to the hut in five flights. The pilots give a safety talk to the group that are flying into the cabin, and check that everyone's radios are programmed properly.

We have employed a coordinator to be at the staging area on the Saturday to help your group unload their baggage, have the waiting room (a yurt) warmed up and the parking areas cleared. Please make their lives easier by packing all food in boxes and having your gear well packed.

## Directions for getting to the staging area:

- 1. Head 52 kms west of Golden or 95 kms east of Revelstoke.
- 2. Exit the TransCanada highway at the Great Canadian Heli-Skiing sign/entrance and take an immediate right hand turn.
- 3. Go one km and angle-park on the right hand side of road.
